**19/0167 To approve the planning application for a fence outside the Parish Office to contain the Chinese takeaway waste bins and to authorise the ensuing costs.**

Members discussed the proposed planning application, enquiring about alternative places that the bins could be stored. Questions were asked as to why the Council were offering to lease the land to the takeaway. They were informed that alternative suggestions had been looked into but the takeaway had nowhere else to store the bins. Cllr Craddock informed the members that the proposed planning application would cost £256 to submit and the fence would cost £750. He was hoping that the takeaway may pay some if not all the cost of the fence. After much discussion it was proposed by Cllr Harber, seconded by Cllr Alison and **RESOLVED** with two against (Cllrs Faulks and May) to submit the planning application and approve the costs.
